INSTRUCTIONS

1. FEES & FORMS. Entry fee **PER** piece (sets considered one piece): \$20 non-member, \$15 for current Allied Arts and/or Cowiche Canyon Conservancy members. Entry fees are **NON-REFUNDABLE**. All paperwork must be clearly **PRINTED**. Illegible means ineligible!
2. SASE. You **MUST** include a self-addressed & stamped envelope for notification. CD's will not be returned.
3. CD. Actual work must be **IDENTICAL** to image on CD.
 - Write your complete name & phone number on the CD itself.
 - All images must be in JPG format, no larger than 500kb
 - TEST CD prior to submission. You will **NOT** be contacted if the CD does not function properly.
 - Files should be named "1,2, or 3-Last name of artist-Title of Work.jpg" (ie. 1-Smith-Building.jpg) Include one image of each submission + one detail. Sets may include one detail of each piece, labeled as 1-A, 1-B, 1-C, etc. 3-D works: include one image + two details, labeled as 1-A, 1-B.
4. ELIGIBILITY. The gallery will accept submissions in the following mediums: sculpture, drawing, jewelry, pottery, prints, fiber arts, painting, and mixed media. **NO PHOTOGRAPHY WILL BE ACCEPTED FOR THIS EXHIBIT.** Work must have been completed within the past three years and **NOT** previously exhibited in the Peggy Lewis Gallery. No more than three entries per artist. *Weight limit:* may not exceed 200 pounds. *Size limit:* 8 feet by 8 feet per piece.
5. PRICING. A value or price must be stated on **ALL** work. Prices should reflect a special 50% gallery commission (half will go to support Allied Arts, and half will go to support Cowiche Canyon Conservancy.) No more than one "not for sale" (NFS) per artist. The value of the NFS item must be stated for insurance purposes.

ACCEPTED MEDIA & ELIGIBILITY

Open to all artists working in sculpture, drawing, jewelry, pottery, prints, fiber arts, painting, and mixed media. Only original work, inspired by the 2,000 acre Cowiche Canyon Conservancy, designed and executed by the exhibiting artist in the past three years is eligible for entry. See www.cowichecanyon.org for details on the scope of the conservancy.

Photography and pieces previously exhibited in the Peggy Lewis Gallery (formerly the Allied Arts Gallery) will not be accepted. See inside for more details.
